She has taught in several universities before becoming Director of Training and Technical Support for JacqCAD Master, software used to design Jacquard woven textiles.

In 2000, Bethanne founded The Jacquard Center, a training retreat for Jacquard Studies in Hendersonville, North Carolina, that attracts designers, professional artists and educators from around the world.
