## rules

- Entries must be handwoven on a loom.
- Entrants may submit up to two entries.
- Must be original designs except where traditional drafts are used and noted.
- Must have been completed within the last two years.
- If a joint effort, all contributors must be named; attach details to entry form (i.e., spinner, dyer, seamstress, etc.).
- Appropriate installation hardware and full instructions **MUST** be included.
- Entries will remain on display throughout the exhibit.
- Pieces greater than 60" in any direction may not be shown in their entirety due to space considerations.
- The BRHS committee reserves the right of final interpretation of these rules.

## amateur/professional definitions

**Amateurs** engage in handweaving as a pastime or hobby. **Professionals** generate income by marketing their work or teaching handweaving. Entrant **MUST** indicate amateur or professional status on entry form.

## category id numbers

There will be amateur and professional divisions in each of the following categories:

- #1 Accessories** - Scarves, purses, jewelry, etc.
- #2 Decorative Functional** - Linens, rugs, pillows, afghans, etc.
- #3 Decorative Non-Functional** - Wall hangings, tapestries, 3-D work, etc.
- #4 Wearable** - Clothing, shawls, etc.
- #5 Yardage** - Minimum of 3 yards in length and 18 - 60 inches in width. Include finished 8 inch square handling swatch. Roll both pieces on a cardboard tube. **DO NOT FOLD**. Entries submitted without a swatch **WILL NOT** be considered in judging.

## entry fee, procedures & waiver

- Entries will be limited to the first 100 Entrants.
- There is a non-refundable fee of \$30 for up to two (2) entries. Make check payable to:
