Please note our policy: A membership application **must** accompany payment in order for you to be included in the annual Membership Directory (available at the April Guild Meeting). Guild membership includes: access to the Guild Library, rental equipment, participation in member programs, shows, retreats, and our monthly newsletter. Members who have e-mail capabilities will receive special e-notices and be advised when the monthly newsletter is available on the website.

Our Guild meetings are held February-November, usually on the fourth Saturday, from 10AM to noon, at The Folk Art Center, home of the Southern Highlands Craft Guild, on the Blue Ridge Parkway, east of Asheville at milepost #382. Visitors are welcome.

Dues (\$25 single; \$30 family) are payable no later than the February meeting each year. A \$5 late fee will be assessed continuing members after that date. Individuals (new members) joining the Guild will pay full dues if they join before July 1. After July 1, new members will be required to pay half the annual dues. To be included in the membership directory, monies must be received by the fourth Saturday in March.
